Requirements and Conditions:

Applicants will be considered on the basis of scholastic achievement, financial need, aptitude, personality, community service, and involvement in church, synagogue, 4-H, Grange, and/or similar organizations.

1. The applicant must be a resident of Rensselaer County for at least 4 years.
2. The applicant must be accepted in an accredited 2 or 4 year college program pursuant to a career in:

Agriculture, Home Economics, Human Ecology, Family Sciences, Forestry, Human or Animal Medicine, Education, Consumer Sciences, Nursing, Natural Resource Mgmt., Environmental Engineering, Pharmacology

Procedure:

1. Complete the attached application and include an official 4 year High School transcript.
2. Write an essay of not less than 200 words, detailing your participation in community organizations and your long range plans and goals.
3. Return the signed application, essay, a reference letter (see application), and transcript by **May 2nd** to:
